Free off-site parking available both weekends of the Fair - Friday through Sunday, August 21-23 and 28-30 at Papa John's Cardinal Stadium. Free tram service sponsored by Miller Transportation will run continuously.

Advance tickets will be sold at all Ticketmaster outlets including all Kroger and Walmart locations, and online at kystatefair.org. Advance tickets for adults are \$8 and children (6-12) and seniors (55+) are \$4. Advance discount parking is \$5. Advance discount ends on August 19 at 10 p.m.
