HELP WANTED FOR THE KENTUCKY STATE FAIR

LOUISVILLE, KY (July 27, 2007) ... Applications for temporary workers for the Kentucky State Fair are being accepted beginning Monday, August 6. Positions for hire include grounds, housekeeping, admission gates, tour guides, tram drivers and maintenance staff. Wages start at \$6.75 an hour, with some positions paying slightly more. The Kentucky State Fair starts on Thursday, August 16 and runs through Sunday, August 26.

Those seeking to apply may do so at the Kentucky State Fair Employment Trailer located next to The Armory and Cracker Barrel (near Gate 4 of the Kentucky Exposition Center) off Crittenden Drive.
