## RULES

### ENTRY DEADLINE: JULY 10

1. Entries in this department must be on livestock form. Entries must be postmarked by July 10. All entries must be accompanied by the correct entry fees.

Jacks (per head) . . . . . \$14.00  
\*Mare and Colt (per head) . . . . . 14.00  
Mules and Jennets (per head) . . . . . 12.00  
\*Mare and Colt is considered one entry.

To enter online, go to [www.kystatefair.org](http://www.kystatefair.org). Complete information must be provided.

**LATE ENTRIES:** Double entry fees will be charged for all entries postmarked after July 10. Late entries must arrive at the Fair office by July 25.

Exhibitors now have the option of an extra late deadline. Entry Fees of \$50 per head will be charged. Extra late entries must arrive at the Fair office by August 3.

2. Please use Gate 4 off Crittenden Drive when bringing stock to the grounds.
3. In classes for young stock, the breeder's written statement of time of birth must be produced upon demand of judge or superintendent.
4. All jacks, 4 years old and over must have proved themselves to be sires. Aged jacks and jennets will be reckoned from date of birth.
5. When on exhibition in the ring, each animal must be under halter or bridle and in the charge of owner or employee.
6. Each animal must be in show condition and deemed worthy by the judge to receive premiums.
7. All exhibitors are limited to winning two premiums and two ribbons in each class. When an animal is owned by two or more people, any one partner will be permitted only one premium money and ribbon in each class. Each animal must be owned by the exhibitor.
8. With proper documentation of entry at another major State Fair, an exhibitor may petition for early release. The request must be made to the Entry Dept. and will not be granted until verified by state fair or livestock show.
9. See General Rules and Regulations for protests and other information.
