Poultry Entry Fee, in all classes - \$3.00 per specimen

GENERAL HEALTH REQUIREMENTS FOR EXHIBITORS:

NPIP Participant with the H5/H7 Avian Influenza clean status with proof of certification.

NPIP participant not having the H5/H7 Avian Influenza status will need a negative Avian Influenza test with certification within 30 days of entry.

Non NPIP flocks must have a negative Pollorum/Typhoid test and a negative Avian Influenza test done within 30 days of entry with test results.

In State Exhibitors will need either their NPIP certificates or will need to be Pollorum/Typhoid tested upon arrival at the fair. We will not test out of state birds at the fair.

SALE COOPS: There will be NO sale coops. Only poultry entered in the show will be allowed on the Fairgrounds. All poultry must remain until 5:00 p.m., Sunday August 19. Exhibitors violating these rules will forfeit all premiums earned. All cooped poultry will be judged as entered.

1. Entries must be made on green entry forms or by online entry. Entries must be postmarked by July 18. Exhibitor admission tickets may be purchased at time entry is made. To enter online, go to the State Fair website at www.kystatefair.org. Complete information is required.
2. The entry form must be completely filled out with breed name, variety and leg band number as well as the correct section number and class number, including a letter. Each bird must be owned by the exhibitor.
3. All exhibitors entering in the youth show (divisions 1651, 1652, 1653, 1654, 1655 and 1656) must be under the age of 19 on the day of the show. Youth may show in either the open division or youth division, but not both.

4. The poultry department will be open for the reception of entries Wednesday, August 15 from 9:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. All stock must be in coops by 9:00 a.m. Thursday, August 16. Judging will be on August 16.
5. Any misrepresentation made by the exhibitor in regard to his stock will forfeit his right and privileges. The judge will disqualify doubtful entries. The burden of proof that the entry is correct will rest with the exhibitor.
6. Any specimens showing symptoms of disease when received or during the exhibition will be immediately returned to the owner. The management reserves the right to reject the entire shipment containing any bird showing infectious disease. Scaly legged, mite or lice infested birds will be refused.
7. The management will use every precaution in this department but will not be responsible for loss or accident. Competent attendants will be assigned to handle the cooping, feeding, and care of all birds. No one will be allowed to handle stock except by permission of the Superintendent or owner. Any special instructions for feeding of birds should be made in writing and attached to entry form.
8. Protests. (See General Rules).
9. **NO COOPS OR BOXES SHOULD BE LEFT IN AISLES.**
10. All specimens will be judged by comparison by latest standard, with due emphasis being placed on type, vigor, and production qualities.
11. All birds will be fed and exhibited in uniform coops by the State Fair Management.
12. No person connected officially with the department as superintendent, judge, or helpers, directly or indirectly, will be permitted to enter any specimen in competition either in his or her own name or in any other name. Knowledge of such will cause such person to lose his or her rights and privileges as an exhibitor and such person will be immediately discharged.
13. Exhibitors will not be permitted to talk with judges until they have completed their work.
14. Birds may be taken home on Sunday, August 19, after 5:00 p.m. All exhibits must be removed by 9:00 p.m., Sunday, August 19. The Fair is not responsible for birds left after this time.
15. **Only bird assigned to a hole can use that hole and must remain entire show. No birds can be sold out of the show.**
16. The Kentucky State Fair reserves the right to limit the number of birds per exhibitor.
17. Exhibitors are limited to winning two premiums and two ribbons in each class. If total of premiums won exceeds amount offered by Fair of \$6,580, then individual premium amounts will be prorated.

DEFINITION OF TERMS

The term “specimen” implies anything for which a premium is offered.

“Cock” - A male specimen hatched prior to 2018.

“Hen” - A female specimen hatched prior to 2018.

“Cockerel” - A male specimen hatched during 2018.

“Pullet” - A female specimen hatched during 2018.

INCLUDE THE DIVISION AND CLASS NUMBER (INCLUDING LETTER) ON THE ENTRY. For example, to enter a Rhode Island Red Hen in the youth show, enter DIVISION 1651, Class 8b.

RULES

1. The 2018 State Fair Rooster Crowing Contest will be held at 2:00 p.m. daily, Thursday, August 16 through Saturday, August 18 and 10:00 a.m. on Sunday, August 19. THE FINALS WILL BE ON THE AFTERNOON OF AUGUST 19 AT 2:00 p.m.
2. The location of the contest will be in the Poultry Department.
3. The contest is open to the world.
4. No entry fee is required.
5. Roosters entered in the rooster crowing contest must meet all Kentucky Department of Agriculture health requirements. For health requirement information, please contact: Kentucky Department of Agriculture, Division of Animal Health, 109 Corporate Dr., Frankfort, KY 40601. Phone (502) 573-0282 Option 3.

For all up to date health regulations for each species of livestock, please contact the Kentucky Department of Agriculture at the address and phone number above, or visit their website at www.kyagr.com.

6. Entries may be made daily up to the start of the contest at the office of the poultry department. However, only 8 roosters can be entered in each contest. Daily Prizes - Courtesy of Feeders Supply Co. and \$5 premium given by Ky. State Fair.
7. Only Roosters winning first place in daily contests will be eligible to compete in the finals. The bird with the largest total for the finals wins the Championship. Prize - Courtesy of Feeders Supply Co. and \$10 premium given by Ky. State Fair.
8. Any ties will be "crowed off" by rules set up by the committee in charge of the contest.
9. Rooster will be penned in individual coops and handlers cannot clap or annoy birds. Exhibitors will not be permitted to disturb rooster during the contest.
10. Exhibitors can bring their roosters to compete any day and take home that night or they may leave it for complete contest. However, only daily first place winners are eligible to compete in Finals on Sunday, August 19, for Grand Champion.

Dues are \$20 per year or \$50 for three years. New members receive a copy of the quarterly and the latest available copy of the Annual American Bantam Association Year Book which lists many advertisers and includes a complete breed and variety index. Winners of ABA awards are listed in the year book under WHO'S WHO IN BANTAMS. Starred wins are earned in classes of 100 or more in the following: Champions and Reserve Champions in the seven bantam divisions, Best and Reserve of Breed and Variety. A single bird is eligible for only one award and can earn only one starred win.

Personalized Certificates to Champion and Reserve Champion Bantam

Pins are awarded for Champion and Reserve for all seven bantam divisions providing there are 25 birds competing. Pins for all starred wins in the show.
